## Office of the Coroner County of Portage, Ohio Dr. Dean J. DePerro, DO Statistical Annual Report - 2017

There were 336 deaths reported to the coroner. Of those reported, 221 cases were eventually referred to an attending physician because they did not meet the definition of a coroner case. Of those 221 deaths referrals, 29 required on-the-scene investigation before a determination could be rendered. One Hundred Nineteen (119) cases became coroner cases as defined by the Ohio Revised Code.
