

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL
LIMITATION**

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution of the Council of Hiram Village, Ohio adopted on July 12, 2016, there will be submitted to the electors of the Village at a general election to be held in the Village at the regular places of voting therein, on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, the question levying a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Village for the purpose of current expenses.

Tax being a renewal of an existing tax of 4.4 mills at a rate not exceeding 4.4 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.44 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2016, first due in calendar year 2017.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. will remain open until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
