

**REPORT OF BARBARA R. OSWICK  
PRESIDING AND ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE  
PORTAGE COUNTY MUNICIPAL COURT  
FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2015**

The Portage County Municipal Court submits the following report of its operation for the calendar year 2015.

The Presiding and Administrative Judge, Barbara R. Oswick, sat in the Ravenna division of the Portage County Municipal Court with Judge Kevin Poland. Judge Mark Fankhauser sat in the Kent division of the Portage County Municipal Court.

Both of the judges in the Ravenna division continued to conduct jail arraignments via interactive video. This system saves the County the time and expense of transporting inmates from the jail to the courthouse for arraignments and improves courthouse security.

Statistics reflect an increase in the number of cases filed in the Ravenna division of the Court. A total of 23,922 criminal and traffic cases were filed in the Ravenna division, reflecting an increase of 2,488 cases over the total for 2014. In the Kent division, 6,579 criminal and traffic cases were filed, a decrease of 86 cases from the total for 2014.

In the Ravenna division, 3,422 civil cases were filed, a decrease of 31 cases over the total filed in 2014. The Kent division reflects an increase of 90 civil cases filed, for a total of 1,578 cases in 2015.

Criminal and traffic receipts for the Ravenna division totaled \$3,650,145.37, an increase of \$190,446.97 from receipts for 2014. In the Kent division, criminal and traffic receipts totaled \$1,247,528.82, a decrease of \$57,069.59 from receipts for 2014.

In 2015, the Judges continued to refer defendants convicted of domestic violence to anger management counseling provided by Family and Community Services and Summit Psychological Associates.

Both Family and Community Services and Summit Psychological Associates also provided counseling for victims of domestic violence so that they could learn new ways of dealing with relationship conflicts. Other defendants received services from Coleman Professional Services and Town Hall II.

The Judges took advantage of the many agencies who offered a variety of counseling opportunities for persons with substance abuse issues. In particular, Townhall II, Summit Psychological Associates, Compass Recovery, and Family and Community Services offered substance abuse assessments and counseling. Because Ohio O.V.I. law mandates counseling for any person who is convicted of O.V.I. two or three times within a six-year period, all of the Judges routinely referred defendants to such counseling. The Judges also referred persons convicted of other alcohol and drug related offenses to counseling at these agencies.

The Judges continued to refer O.V.I. offenders to Town Hall II or Family and Community Services to complete a three day Driver Intervention Program in Portage County in lieu of three days in jail pursuant to statutory requirements. The assignment of each defendant to a specific agency was done randomly.

In addition, the Judges continued to order persons convicted of underage O.V.I. to complete an eight hour education program administered by Family and Community Services, Driver Education-8 (DEC8). The program is limited to underage offenders with a blood alcohol level between .02 and .08.

The Portage County Municipal Court continued to have its own probation department separate and apart from that of the Common Pleas Court and that department continued to oversee the Dual Diagnosis Offenders Program. When it appears that an offender might have a mental or emotional disorder, as well as a substance abuse problem, the Court may refer that person to

the probation department for an evaluation. If the offender qualifies for DDOP, he or she receives counseling and treatment for both substance abuse and the mental or emotional condition.

The Municipal Court Probation Department also continued to monitor attendance at most of the court ordered assessments and counseling programs. It also supervised those who were placed on probation or were ordered to perform community service, as well as those who were ordered to make restitution to victims for property damage or medical expenses.

The Municipal Court Probation Department administered the SCRAM (secured continuous remote alcohol monitoring) program whereby defendants were outfitted with ankle bracelets that monitored their use of alcohol on a 24 hour basis, for an extended period of time, normally at least 3 months. This device was used primarily on defendants who prior to trial had 1 or more previous convictions of O.V.I. within the last 6 years or received multiple O.V.I. convictions and were placed on probation after completing a jail sentence. SCRAM units were also installed on defendants who committed crimes other than O.V.I. but were alcohol-related. Additionally, the Municipal Court Probation Department monitored all O.V.I. offenders who were required to use ignition interlock for driving privileges during the entire period of their license suspensions. The legislation requires ignition interlock on all vehicles driven by persons who have been convicted of second or third O.V.I. offenses within a six year time period. The Municipal Court Probation Department also monitored house arrest by electronic monitoring (HAEM) through the use of SCRAM bracelets with 24/7 location monitoring capabilities.

The Municipal Court utilized a diversion program for persons convicted of possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages while under the age of twenty-one. Only persons without prior alcohol related convictions were eligible for this program. Following a plea of guilty, the offender completed a substance abuse assessment and counseling as recommended, as well as a

two (2) hour educational program called "Think About Your Future," and sixteen (16) hours of community work service. If the offender completed the program and committed no further violations for six (6) months, the plea was vacated and the charge was dismissed at the offender's cost. The offender was then eligible to have the record sealed. This program continued to be administered by Family and Community Services.

The Marijuana Diversion Program ("BIC 60") is administered by Family and Community Services. A first time offender charged with possession of marijuana or possession of marijuana-related paraphernalia may enter the program upon a plea of guilty to either or both charges. The offender must successfully complete the program requirements and must commit no other drug related offenses for a period of three (3) months. Upon successful completion, the offender's plea is vacated and the matter is dismissed, at the offender's cost. The offender is then eligible to have the record sealed.

The Judges continued to use the Mental Health Diversion Program, established in 2006, with collaboration from the Portage County Mental Health and Recovery Board, Coleman Professional Services, Townhall II and Family and Community Services. This program was developed to manage individuals with severe and persistent mental health issues. The program is designed to divert individuals with mental health issues away from jail and coordinate mental health treatment. The Municipal Court Probation Department monitored the progress of participants in the Mental Health Diversion Program. Judge Barbara Oswick presided over these court proceedings, and will continue to do so in 2016. Case managers from Coleman Professional Services continue to serve as liaisons between the criminal justice system and the mental health system to work with those individuals. In October, 2015 Judge Oswick applied for, and subsequently received initial certification from the Ohio Supreme Court for a specialized docket mental health court

known as "STAR Court". It is anticipated that STAR Court will receive full certification as a specialized docket mental health court after the Supreme Court representative conduct a site visit in May 2016.


With the assistance of Information Technology Services, Court schedules, local rules, many pleadings and other papers continued to be available to the general public via the internet.

The Municipal Court continues to accumulate monies through a special projects fund, established in 2006, to fund the construction of the new courthouse in Kent, which opened in April of 2014.

For the year 2016 Judge Kevin Poland has been designated by the other judges to serve as presiding and administrative judge.

The Court wishes to thank the past Clerk of Courts, Linda Fankhauser and current Clerk of Courts, Jill Fankhauser and her staff, the County Commissioners, the Municipal Court Probation Department and all law enforcement agencies and personnel for their cooperation and assistance during the year.





## Total Cases Filed






## Total Cases Disposed




## Percentage of Criminal Disbursements


